

What's the process in getting approved for the state of ILLINOIS?

1. Find your closest workforce location in your area, click on location tab: https://www.illinoisworknet.com/Training/Pages/WIOATrainingProgramSearch.aspx

Halfway down page <u>under</u> WIOA Approved Training Program Search there is a <u>link</u> to locate the closest workforce to your residence

To apply for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Services you will need to contact an Illinois workNet Center. To find a location, search your city or ZIP code on the Illinois workNet Service Finder.

- 2. Contact your closest local workforce request eligibility screening for a WIOA Grant for training
- 3. Provide the caseworker a Proposal & Acceptance letter here: https://codingclarified.com/proposal-and-acceptance-pdf-form/
- 4. Provide caseworker with CIP Code 51.0713


Title: Medical Insurance Coding Specialist/Coder.

Definition: A program that prepares individuals to perform specialized data entry, classification, and record-keeping procedures related to medical diagnostic, treatment, billing, and insurance documentation. Includes instruction in medical records and insurance software applications, basic anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, fundamentals of medical science and treatment procedures, data classification and coding, data entry skills, and regulations relating to Medicare and insurance documentation.
