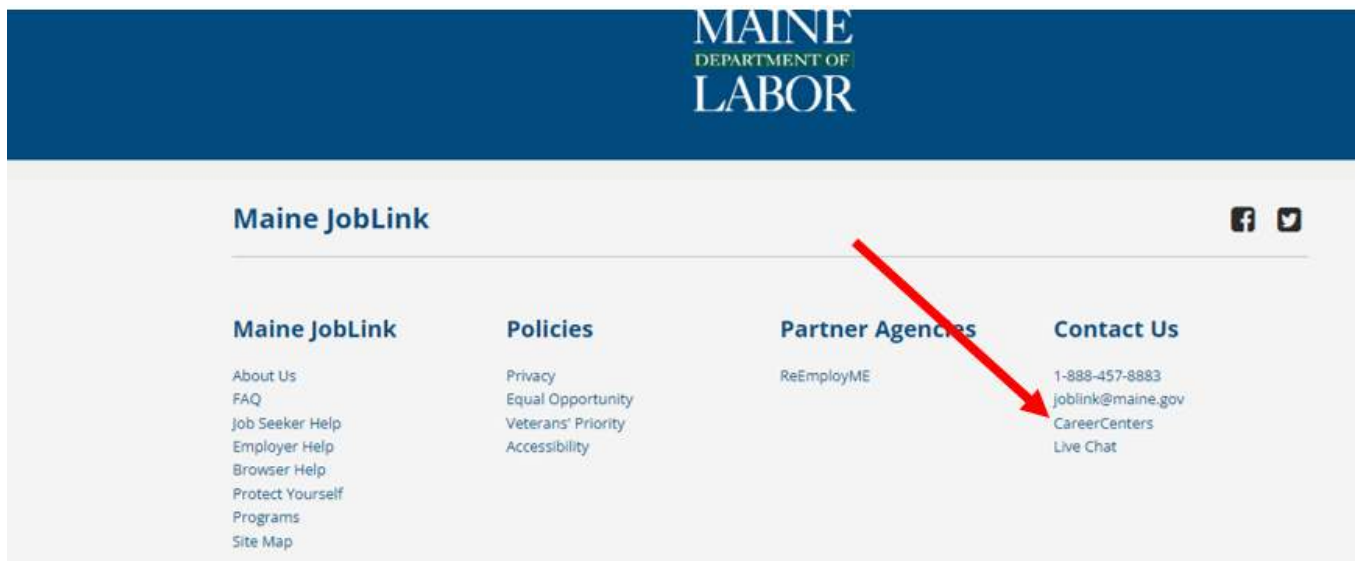




What's the process in getting approved for the state of Maine?

1. Find your closest workforce location in your area by visiting the below link:

2. At the bottom of the page under **CONTACT US** you will click **Career Centers**



3. Click on the closest Workforce Center to your residence
