



What's the process in getting approved for the state of South Dakota?

1. Find your closest workforce location in your area by visiting the following link:
https://dlr.sd.gov/workforce_services/individuals/default.aspx

2. Select the closest location under the drop down menu for **Find Your Job Service Office**

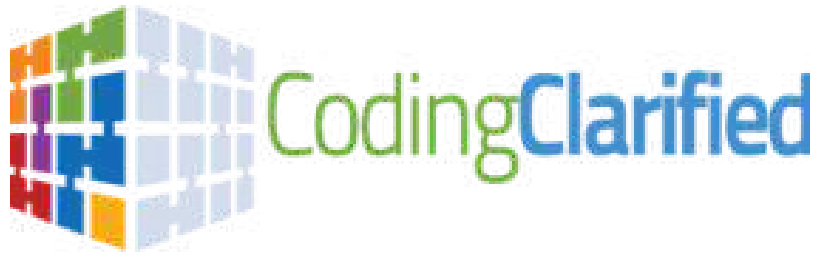
4. Click on the link below and complete it to its entirety. This link will create your Proposal & Acceptance letter that you need to provide to your Caseworker.
