1. Find your closest workforce location in your area:

2. Contact your closest local workforce **request eligibility screening for a WIOA OR WRG Grant** for training through Coding Clarified for medical coding
3. Provide the caseworker a Proposal & Acceptance letter here:

INTraining presents a broad and diverse selection of occupational training programs that support the employment goals of Indiana's workforce. INTraining is comprised of two lists: INTraining and the Eligible Training Provider (ETP) list.

The INTraining list is an inclusive list of all training provider applicants whose training programs meet the basic application standards set by the State of Indiana Department of Workforce Development (DWD).

The ETP list is a subset listing of INTraining providers whose training programs meet additional demand and performance criteria set by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) and DWD. These programs are eligible for WIOA funding through the local WorkOne office.

ETP programs are indicated with the following icons:
