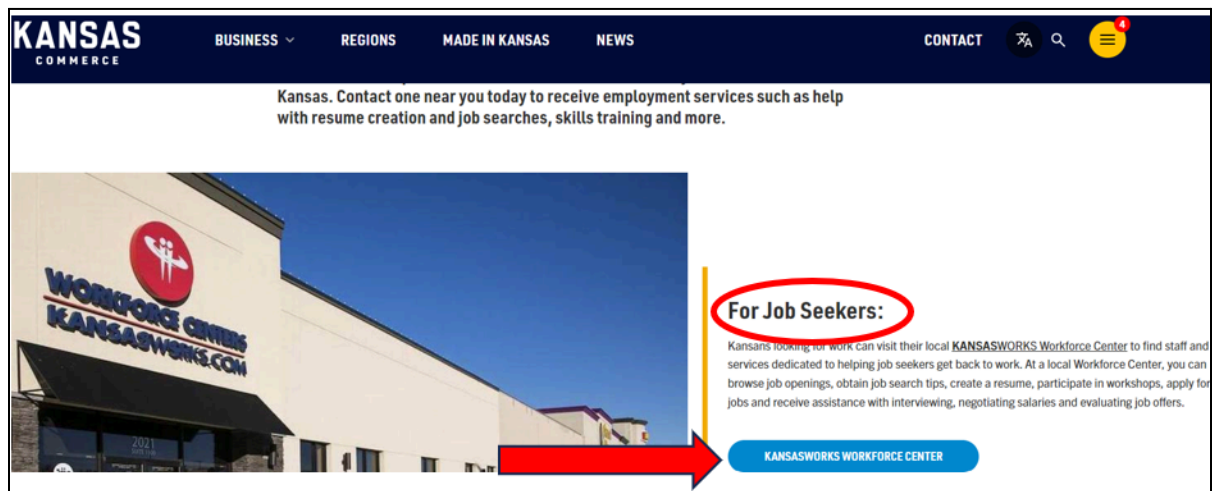




What's the process in getting approved for the state of Kansas?
