


## What's the process in getting approved for the state of Iowa?

- 1. Find the closest workforce location in your area by visiting the following link: <a href="lowaWORKS">lowaWORKS</a>
- 2. Click on "Contact Us" at the bottom of the website.



- 3. Select one of the 3 options to find the closest location
  - a. Location Search (Zip Code)
  - b. Map of Location
  - c. All Locations (List of all locations)



- 4. Contact your closest local workforce and request eligibility screening for a WIOA Grant for training (WRITE DOWN YOUR ASSIGNED CASE WORKERS NAME & EMAIL AS YOU WILL NEED THAT FOR THE NEXT STEP)
- 5. Required information to complete this step:
  - ☐ Your local Caseworkers contact information (Name & Email address)


Title: Medical Insurance Coding Specialist/Coder.

Definition: A program that prepares individuals to perform specialized data entry, classification, and record-keeping procedures related to medical diagnostic, treatment, billing, and insurance documentation. Includes instruction in medical records and insurance software applications, basic anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, fundamentals of medical science and treatment procedures, data classification and coding, data entry skills, and regulations relating to Medicare and insurance documentation.


How to verify Coding Clarified is an APPROVED training provider in your state

- 2. Under Job Seekers section click the drop down for Additional Services then click on Training Services






3. Click on ETPL Approved Programs
