

What's the process in getting approved for the state of Wisconsin?

- 1. Find your closest workforce location in your area by visiting the following link: <u>https://www.wisconsinjobcenter.org/directory/</u>
- 2. Click on the location closest to your residence



- 3. Contact your closest local workforce and request eligibility screening for a WIOA Grant for training (WRITE DOWN YOUR ASSIGNED CASE WORKERS NAME & EMAIL AS YOU WILL NEED THAT FOR THE NEXT STEP)
- 4. Click on the link below and complete it to its entirety. This link will create your Proposal & Acceptance letter that you need to provide to your Caseworker.

** NOTE: Start Date needs to be at least 2 weeks from today's date https://codingclarified.com/proposal-and-acceptance-pdf-form/

Title: Medical Insurance Coding Specialist/Coder.

Definition: A program that prepares individuals to perform specialized data entry, classification, and record-keeping procedures related to medical diagnostic, treatment, billing, and insurance documentation. Includes instruction in medical records and insurance software applications, basic anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, fundamentals of medical science and treatment procedures, data classification and coding, data entry skills, and regulations relating to Medicare and insurance documentation.

How to verify Coding Clarified is an APPROVED training provider in your state

The Eligible Training Program List (ETPL) is a list of training programs that WIOA program participants generally must use to select training that can be funded by WIOA. Additionally, TAA program participants are encouraged to use the ETPL when selecting TAA-funded training. The WIOA and TAA programs are available through Wisconsin's job centers.
WIOA and TAA program participants must get approval from their career planner to receive training funds. Participants will not be reimbursed if they start training before receiving career planner approval. There may be limitations on the amount of financial assistance available to individual participants and the types of training programs WIOA and TAA will support. Training institutions on the ETPL only receive WIOA or TAA funding if and when participants enroll in their training program(s).
